

Expression of Interest Allied Health Professional Rural Generalist Program – Scholarship (Module MO1005 Strategies for Rural and Remote Service Delivery).

BACKGROUND:

The Darling Downs and West Moreton PHN in collaboration with Health Workforce Queensland, invites allied health professionals working in the Darling Downs and West Moreton region to apply for a scholarship to complete one module of the Allied Health Rural Generalist Program.

The Allied Health Rural Generalist Program is presented by James Cook University's internationally recognised Division of Tropical Health and Medicine. The program has been developed in collaboration with the Queensland University of Technology and the Department of Health, Queensland.

This is practical, work-integrated development for early career professionals designed to meet the needs of rural and remote health services.

YOUR OPPORTUNITY:

An opportunity exists for allied health professionals to complete one module in the Allied Health Rural Generalist pathway.

Module MO1005 Strategies for Rural and Remote Service Delivery, introduces participants to key strategies for health service delivery relevant to rural and remote settings. Through work-based activities, participants explore a chosen strategy for the health service and identify health service processes and clinical practices required to successfully implement the chosen strategy. The module will run for six weeks and require approximately 22 hours of work to complete the workplace focused tasks.
