Everyone must learn how to harness their respective power and find a balance between them or be condemned to life without peace and without purpose."

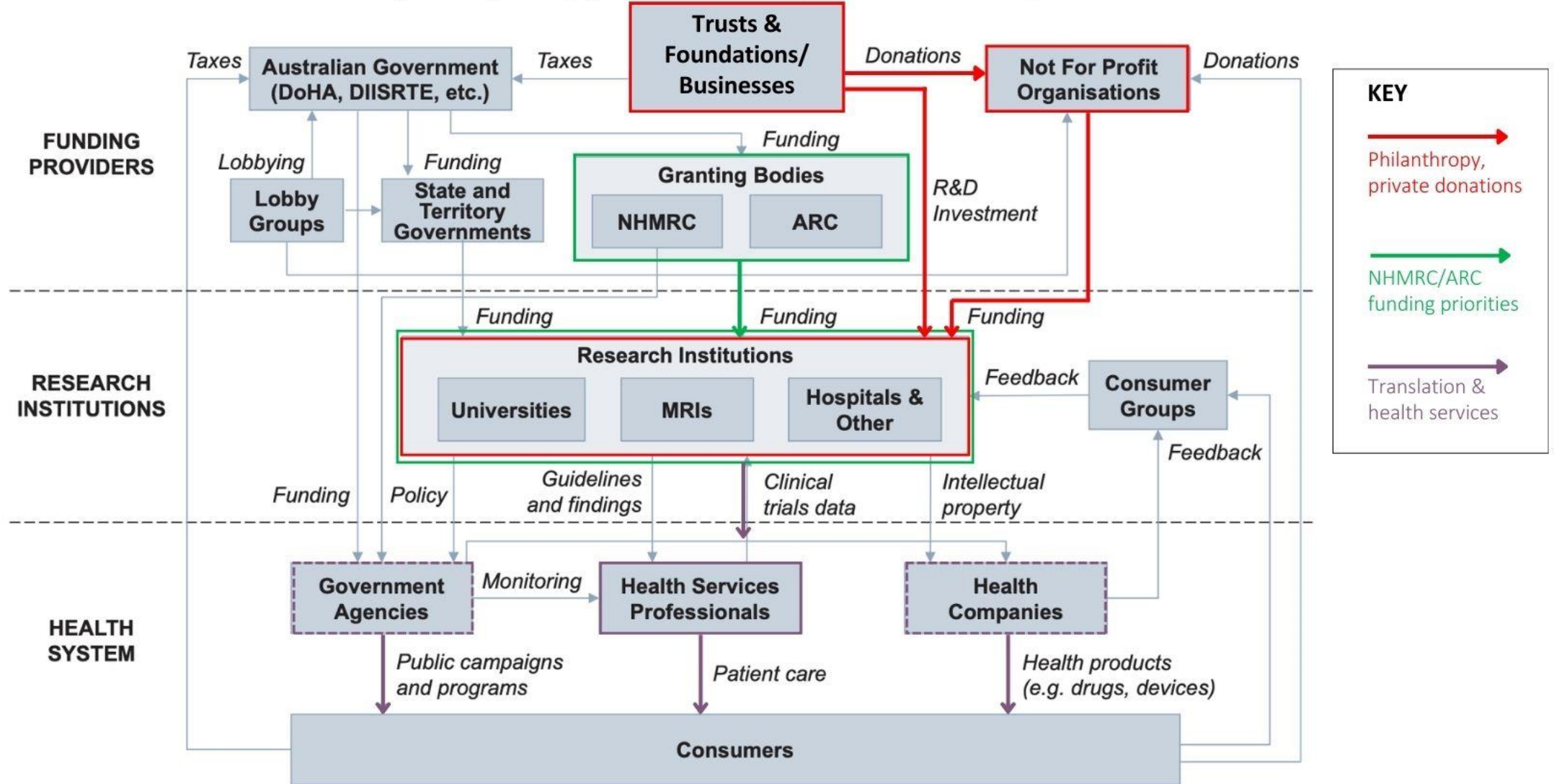
"And in the end", asks the child, "which wolf wins?"

"Ah well, that depends entirely on which wolf you feed..."

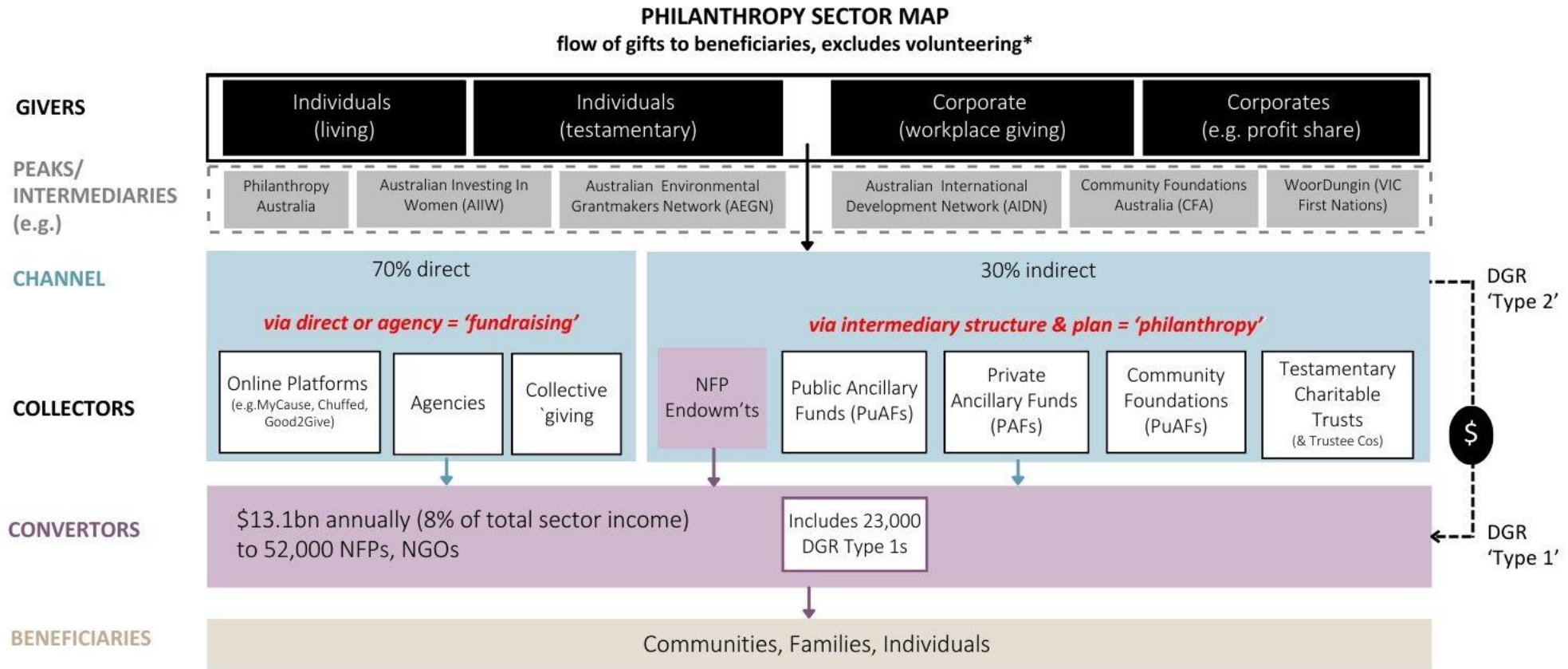
The McKeon Review (2013) mapped health system funding...

Philanthropy, defined as **structured giving via an intermediary**, complements direct or 'retail' giving to 50,000+ charities

In Australia, we have the additional layer of Deductible Gift Recipient (DGR) entities being either classed as Type 2 ('ancillary funds' like PAFs or PuAFs) and Type 1 (and its many sub-classes), where Type 2s can only distribute to Type 1s (as per 'ancillary fund guidelines' governed by the ATO)



*The value of volunteering to the non-profit sector is 1.7 times the value of every dollar donated (Cause Report, 2016, JBWere)
