Call for abstracts

OVERVIEW

The Cunningham Centre, in collaboration with the Darling Downs and West Moreton PHN, invites abstract submissions for the 2021 Allied Health Showcase from Allied Professionals and Assistants. The aim of the Allied Health Showcase is to provide a platform for Allied and Oral Health Professionals and Assistants in the Darling Downs region to network and present their quality improvement projects from respective workplaces to the wider Allied Health community. The showcase will provide an opportunity for smaller quality projects that have interdisciplinary or wider health service application to be presented to a targeted audience.

ABSTRACT SUBMISSIONS

Abstract submissions are encouraged from Allied and Oral Health Professionals and Assistants working in the Darling Downs region. Submissions should focus on the application of current work to an interdisciplinary context and/or innovation of current practice in the time of COVID-19.

A 250 word abstract detailing the following will be required:

- author details
- relevant stream
- problem /issue addressed
- goals/aims
- methods/process undertaken
- results
- conclusions/lessons learned.

Please use the following abstract template to submit your abstracts. All abstracts will be assessed by the panel of reviewers based on the abstract guidelines. Depending on abstract submissions, the panel of reviewers retain the right to offer a poster opportunity rather than a presentation to certain applicants based on merits of the application.

Successful applications will be informed by email. All presentations will be 10 minutes duration with 5 minutes question time.

Continuing Professional Development (CPD) hours will be allocated for each hour of education attended.
