This is WHAT WE HEARD...

Overall, you gave your confidence level in accessing health services in our region a score of **4.1 out of 10.**

What you thought about access to healthcare



You mentioned...

- long travel distances because the service is not available in your area
- families struggling to get to services because of financial problems
- long wait times to get an appointment, and sometimes no same-day appointments when needed
- not enough time during your appointment to discuss all of the things you wanted to.

You also raised...

- the impact of COVID-19 restrictions on seeing your doctor
- the value of telehealth services to get advice and care when you needed it.

What you thought could be done better



You would like to see...

- primary healthcare services located in your local community
- home visits or telehealth options offered by your healthcare provider
- better access to interpreter services
- more services including pharmacies available after-hours, such as before and after school.

You also suggested...

- more promotion and information about available services
- alternative places to receive care, so you don't have to wait for an appointment or go to hospital
- more affordable allied health and disability support services, such as more bulk billing.
