

West Moreton Request for Advice (RFA)

West Moreton GP's can request written non-urgent clinical advice through GP Smart referrals, using the Request for Advice (RFA) function and receive a response within five business days. Please do not request urgent advice via this method. Using the RFA function is **not** a referral to West Moreton Health but is a request for clinical advice which may eliminate the need for a specialist face to face outpatient consultation.

GP Request for Advice – Mater eConsultant

West Moreton GP's can access Mater Health eConsultant Request for advice (RFA) service which provides specialist advice on diagnostic and/or treatment options for their patients within three business days. Specialities include: endocrinology, cardiology, dermatology, respiratory & sleep, neurology, renal and obstetric medicine. Using RFA Mater Health eConsultant is not a referral to Mater Health but is a request for timely clinical advice which may eliminate the need for a specialist face to face outpatient consultation.
