Acute Mental Health Referrals

The Acute Care Team (ACT) is the access point for referrals to West Moreton Mental Health Services.

ACT criteria

Patient presenting with a significant mental health concern in an emergency or crisis situation, needing immediate attention where their safety or others' safety is or may be at imminent risk.

ACT can support patients presenting with a significant, acute mental health concern via the three main areas of the team:

- Ipswich Hospital Emergency Department
- 2. MH CALL
- 3. ACT Community

Referrals to the Crisis Support Space are also coordinated via ACT.
