



There have now been additional areas of NSW declared as hotspots. In addition to Northern Beaches, Greater Sydney has now also been declared as a hotspot.

- Anyone who was in the Northern Beaches region on or since Friday 11 December 2020 and arrived in Queensland **before** 1am Saturday 19 December, must get tested and quarantine in their home or accommodation for 14 days from the date they left the hotspot.
- Anyone who was in the Northern Beaches region on or since Friday 11 December 2020 and arrived in Queensland on a flight from Sydney **after** 1am Saturday 19 December 2020 must go into hotel quarantine at their own expense for 14 days from the date they left the hotspot, and get tested.
- Anyone who was in Greater Sydney on or since Friday 11 December 2020 and arrived in Queensland **before** 1am Monday 21 December 2020 should get tested and quarantine at home or in accommodation until they get a negative result.
- Any non-Queensland resident who was in Greater Sydney on or since Friday 11 December 2020 and arrives in Queensland **after** 1am Monday 21 December 2020 needs an exemption and must go into hotel quarantine at their own expense for 14 days from the date they arrived in Queensland, and get tested.
- Any Queensland resident who was in Greater Sydney on or since Friday 11 December 2020 and arrived in Queensland **before** 1am Tuesday 22 December 2020 should get tested and quarantine at home for 14 days from the date they left the hotspot.
- Any Queensland resident who was in Greater Sydney on or since Friday 11 December 2020 and arrived in Queensland **after** 1am Tuesday 22 December 2020 must go into hotel quarantine at their own expense for 14 days from the date they arrived in Queensland, and get tested.

Once you get to a testing clinic here's what will happen:

1. Check your details

We will ask you some questions. These questions include your name and phone number and information about your symptoms.

2. COVID-19 test

We will do a swab test. To do the test we need to put a swab stick into your mouth and/or nose. It might feel a little uncomfortable.

3. If you feel unwell

You may have to stay in the hospital if you feel unwell. If you feel ok, you may be told to self-isolate in your home or accommodation until you receive your test results. This means go straight to your house and stay there. Do not go to the supermarket or anywhere else.

4. Wait for your test results

You will receive your test results in a SMS text message within 72 hours. If you start to feel worse, phone your doctor or 13 HEALTH (13 43 25 84). Please remain in quarantine while waiting for your test results.

5. Quarantine

Please refer to the details in the hotspot list for your specific quarantine requirements. These requirements differ, depending on whether you are a Queensland resident or not, and whether you have been in the Northern Beaches hotspot or the Greater Sydney hotspot.
