

TALK ABOUT campaign sharing guidance and examples

TALK ABOUT is a way for Darling Downs and West Moreton PHN to ask the community about their experience with healthcare in our region.

We want to ensure that health care is planned around the needs of people in our region and by listening to our communities, we can better understand what's working well and what could be done better. We may also be able to better understand the barriers that make accessing services difficult.

Anyone in the community can contribute to TALK ABOUT, including health professionals. We are also looking for people to help us to get the word out.
